

Official Rules for I&M Canal National Heritage Area 35th Anniversary Lock 16 Visitors Center Annual Celebration

OFFICIAL RULES: By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of Sponsor, which shall be binding and final as to all matters related to the I&M Canal National Heritage Area 35th Anniversary Lock 16 Visitors Center Annual Celebration “program”. The I & M Canal National Heritage Area 35th Anniversary Lock 16 Annual Celebration is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws.

TIMING: The I & M Canal National Heritage Area 35th Anniversary Lock 16 Visitors Center Annual Celebration program begins at 11:00 a.m. (CT) on Wednesday, October 9, 2019 and ends at 5:00 p.m. (CT) on Sunday, August 23, 2020 (“35th Anniversary Celebration Period”).

ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION: ONLY PERSONS WHO ARE EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER ARE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE UNITED STATES. DO NOT PROCEED FURTHER IF YOU ARE NOT LOCATED IN THE ELIGIBILITY AREA OR DO NOT MEET THE AGE REQUIREMENTS.

HOW TO PARTICIAPTE: There is no fee to participate. Visitors may sign up at the I & M Canal National Heritage Area 35th Anniversary Lock 16 Visitors Center program on the supplied i-pads. here is no purchase necessary to participate.

PRIZES: Participants who sign up are eligible to win prizes. A prize will be awarded each month of the contest period. Prizes may include event tickets, t-shirts, mule-pulled boat ride tickets, gift certificates for Lock 16 Café & Gift Shop, and other prizes as determined by the Canal Corridor Association.

PRIZE REDEMPTION: One winner each month will be contacted by an email notification that they are the prize winner of the month. To redeem prizes, the winner must respond within 7 days or an alternate winner will be selected. Prizes will be mailed to winners within 30 days of notification. All participants agree to abide by these Official Rules. The program is subject to all federal, state and local laws, and is void where prohibited by law. By participating in the program, participants agree that Illinois courts shall have jurisdiction over any dispute or litigation arising from or relating to this program.

VALIDITY AND ELIGIBILITY OF PARTICIPANTS: Sponsor shall be the sole judge of the validity and eligibility of all Participants.
