About us... The Lock 16 Café, Gift Shop, the I&M Canal Visitor Center, and the I&M Canal Boat are operated by the nonprofit Canal Corridor Association (CCA) (501c3). The I&M Canal Boat is a replica 1848 mule-pulled canal boat located on the Illinois & Michigan Canal, traveling on the same hand-dug waterway as pioneers. From May to October, hour-long boat rides are narrated by period-dressed crew taking guests back to life on the American Frontier and Illinois Prairie. Operations are sustained through the revenue generated from boat rides and from sales of food and merchandise. The I&M Canal Boat was built, and the Visitor Center rehabbed with grants from the state and federal government and donations from foundations, corporations, and individuals. The CCA coordinates activities in the I&M Canal National Heritage Corridor and helps make the I&M Canal a resource for learning. It works to preserve history, protect nature and open space, and creates destinations for learning and fun along the I&M Canal, from Chicago to LaSalle-Peru
